- We have two offices in Brighton, Colorado.
- Local operations are run by Colorado-native & Firestone resident.
- Our Director of Engineering is also a Colorado resident and a graduate of the Colorado School of Mines.
- We have a strong preference for local hiring. ~90% local hires to date.

## Project Overview

### Discovery's Boardwalk Pipeline Project

Provides a safe, environmentally-friendly and efficient oil and gas transportation method that substantially decreases tanker truck traffic, emissions, noise and dust in Adams County, resulting in safer roadways and improvements to the environment.

### Discovery's Brings

- An experienced management team with a proven track record.
- A culture of safety. Safety is not just our #1 priority, it is embedded into the way we think and everything we do.
- Pipelines - the safest and most environmentally friendly way to transport oil and natural gas.
- Reduced truck traffic and emissions.
- Reductions in the size of many well pads
- Quick land reclamation: we reclaim the land to its original state using native plants & grasses.
- An understanding that our success is dependent on our relationship with the community.

## Boardwalk Pipeline Project

- Co-located natural gas & crude oil gathering pipelines.
- We may install an additional, co-located water line.
- Crosses portions of Adams and Weld Counties.
- Phase I: Eastern portion
  - Unanimously approved by Adams and Weld County commissioners
  - Under construction
- Phase II: Western portion
  - Surveying is almost complete
  - We are in the process of securing right-of-way (ROW) easements
  - Preparing to submit permit applications

# III. Importance of Pipelines

## Importance of Pipelines

### Critical and Valuable

- More than 2.7 million miles of pipeline crisscross our country
- Pipelines are a critical part of our nation's energy infrastructure.
- These pipelines are the underground highways that transport oil and gas from where they're produced to where they are needed to provide fuel, electricity, and other important byproducts that we all use every day.

### Largely Invisible

- Once in place, the surface is quickly restored.
- Pipelines are largely invisible to the community.

# Safety

## Pipelines

- According to the National Transportation Safety Board, pipelines are the safest way to transport oil and gas.
- Pipelines significantly decrease tanker truck traffic, which increases safety.

## A Culture Valuing Safety

- **Discovery has a zero-incident safety record and a zero-incident record with the EPA and OSHA.** We have never had a Notice of Violation (NOV).
- We set high standards for ourselves, and have a company-wide culture of safety.
- We meet and exceed industry best practice safety standards.
- We use all-steel pipe for our oil and gas lines. Our pipe is made in the USA.
- We bury our pipelines 4 feet underground, rather than the standard 3 feet. We bury to 5 feet at road crossings.
- We use thicker, stronger, higher grade pipe than best practice standards require.
- We adhere to strict-welding standards and X-ray 100% of our welds (as opposed to the minimum standard of 20%).
- We have a rigorous pipeline integrity management program.

# Environmental

## Pipelines

- Reduce tanker traffic
- Increase safety
- Reduce emissions
- Protect roadways from damage
- Reduce noise
- Reduce the size of many well pads

## Responsibility and Reclamation

- We reclaim our right-of-ways as quickly as possible.
- Following reclamation we monitor and maintain all ROWs.
- We work closely with landowners to restore the land to its original state or better using native plants and grasses.

# Community

## Good Neighbors

- We recognize the importance of being both a good neighbor and a responsible operator.
- We approach this role with a focus on safety & stewardship.
- We work to have a positive impact on our communities.
- We make it a priority to volunteer and support organizations in the communities where we work, with a focus on youth sports, Boys and Girls Clubs, and events like rodeos and county fairs.

## Good Economic Partners

- Our operations generate economic development through jobs, tax revenue and ROW payments to local landowners.
- Pipelines reduce cost of roadway maintenance & repairs.
- We currently have two offices in Brighton and prefer to hire locally. 90% of our hires to date have been local.
